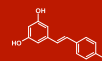


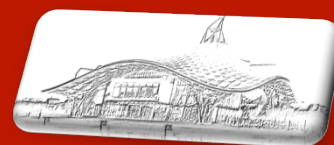


Workshop NutriOx 2014
